SFL Summer Camp Scholarship Policy

Purpose:

The SFL Summer Camp Scholarship Fund has been established in order to ensure all Saskatchewan youth have access to attend the camp.

Background:

The Scholarship Fund is accumulated throughout the year from voluntary donations. The fund will be administered by the Saskatchewan Federation of Labour in accordance with the policies laid out in this document.

Eligibility Requirements:

Any Saskatchewan youth between the ages of 13 and 16 are eligible to apply. However, the youth is not eligible if they have received full or partial registration fees from any union or sponsoring organization. Scholarships may not be awarded to the same youth two years in a row and there is a limit of one (1) scholarship per family per year.

How to Apply:

Following or accompanying the Summer Camp registration form, applicants must complete a scholarship application form and submit it to the SFL office, either by mail or email, no later than the deadline indicated on the application form. All scholarship application forms will be kept confidential.

Selection Process:

The SFL Camp Director(s), in consultation with the SFL Secretary-Treasurer and appropriate SFL staff, will determine how many and to whom scholarships will be awarded. The number of available scholarships will be based on available funding. Immediately on or before the deadline, all scholarship applications will be reviewed and awarded accordingly. Alternate recipients will be ranked on a waiting list and be eligible for a scholarship only in the event of a cancellation. On or before the deadline, scholarship applicants will be advised, in writing, if scholarship funding has been applied to their registration fee. Applicants will also be notified whether or not they have been added to a waiting list.

What is Covered?

Each scholarship will be awarded in an amount equal to the partial or full registration fee.

Payment:

Once the scholarship recipients have been chosen, the scholarship amount will be transferred onto the registration fee by the SFL Accounting Department. In the event that a participant withdraws from Summer Camp, the scholarship money will be credited to the fee payment of the next person on the waiting list.
