# logistics

## DETAILS

The camp will begin Saturday afternoon, August 9<sup>th</sup>, and end the following Friday morning, August 15<sup>th</sup>.

Staff at our camp include Youth Activity Coordinators (YACs), recreation staff, counsellors, food service professionals, and camp nurses.

Early bird registration is **\$750 per camper** (\$850 for non-SFL affiliates). After April 30, registration is \$850 (\$950 for non-SFL affiliates).

**Full payment must accompany completed registration in order to qualify.**

Some affiliated unions subsidize this cost – check with your union local. Arrangement for payment by the union is the responsibility of the camper's parent(s)/guardian(s).

Limited scholarships are available. Our goal is to ensure no one is excluded because of cost.
