Our camp empowers young people through active learning, cooperative recreation, and funfocused social events.

Activity is the cornerstone of any summer camp – we offer campers the chance to zipline, play field games, craft, wall climb, and more!

Through activity and presentations, campers dive into unions, organizing, worker rights and safety, and equality. All the while, campers challenge and resist ageism, ableism, transphobia, homophobia, sexism, racism and other issues that are important to navigating the world as a young person and young worker.

Campers will also participate (and even lead!) in a host of fun activities, including a talent night, initiative tasks, bonfires, and much more! The farewell dance on the last night is always a highlight for campers.
